The Wave Pre-Kindergarten Skill Foundations

Primary Skills

These skills are our first priority as we are preparing our students for kindergarten.

- 1. Knows their first & last name, birthday & age
- 2. Prints their name
- 3. Recognizes letters & some of their sounds
- 4. Recognizes & draws simple shapes
- 5. Counts & recognizes numbers 0-31

- 6. Cuts with some accuracy
- 7. Draws themselves with some details
- 8. Repeats a 6-8 word sentence
- 9. Grips & controls pencil correctly
- 10. Follows multi-step directions

Secondary Skills

These skills are our second priority and will be focused on as students develop the Primary Skills.

- 1. Counts to 20-50-100
- 2. Counts by 1s, 10s, 5s
- 3. Writes some numbers
- 4. Express self verbally & clearly understood
- 5. Takes care of toilet needs independently
- 6. Maintains self control
- 7. Works independently
- 8. Can transition between tasks easily
- 9. Walk a straight line

Further Kindergarten Readiness Skills

These skills will be introduced throughout the year based on the students' development level. We do not expect all Pre-K students to master these skills by the end of the year.

Academic

- Answers questions about a short story
- Knows some rhyming words
- Knows the meanings of simple words
- Knows opposites (hot/cold)
- Knows positional words (top/bottom)
- Can count objects (1:1 correspondence)
- Can put together a simple puzzle
- Can count on to do simple addition

Motor

- Run, jump, hop, march
- Stand on one foot 5 to 10 seconds
- Walk backward for 5 feet
- Throws a ball
- Paste pictures on a paper
- Tie a knot, zip, or button
- Knows left from right

Social Development

- Identifies other children by name
- · Cares for own belongings
- Gets along with other children
- Recognizes authority
- Shares with others
- Talks easily
- Helps with clean up & puts toys away
- Age appropriate attention span
- Recognizes body parts
- Knows parents' names
